Mr. White reported that the airport is now owner of a courtesy vehicle. Said vehicle was donated by a Baton Rouge agency.

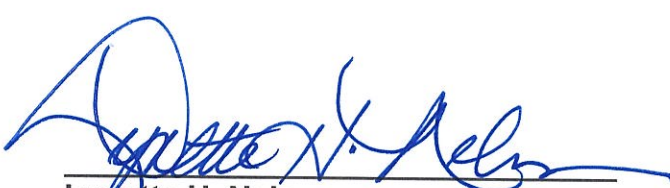
