The following ordinance was introduced for consideration.

An Ordinance

Suspending all requirements that the city inspect housing prior to installation of utilities and further providing with respect thereto.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of New Roads, Louisiana:

Section 1. All requirements that the City of New Roads inspect housing prior to installation of utilities arehereby suspended.

Section 2. This suspension shall last throughout the term of the Governor's COVID-19 Public Health Emergency Proclamation.

Section 3. This ordinance is adopted as an emergency measure and shall be effective upon approval of the mayor.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Should any provisions of this ordinance, or the application thereof, be held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of thisordinance.

Motion by Mr. Kellerman and seconded by Mr. White.

RESOLVED, That the ordinance be adopted.
