Adoption of Minutes of Meeting of April 20,2021

P.C. Parish Council – Request to waive Wm. H. Scott Civic Center rental fee (V. Davis)

Ms. Broussard informed the council that she had received a request to waive the rental fee from the parish council. She further stated that the purpose of the rental is to conduct a public hearing on May 6, 2021 on the proposed planning and zoning ordinance.

Motion by Mr. Smith and seconded by Mr. Davis.

RESOLVED, That the request be approved contingent on the execution of a cooperative endeavor agreement.

Discussion of proposed amendment to the City of New Roads Land Use Regulations relative to the maximum age of Manufactured Homes. Subparagraph B. 8 of Section 1.8 of Chapter 1 1 of Article VI would be amended to extend the original manufacturing date from twenty(20) to thirty (30) years prior to the date of application- (Joy Nelson, Sandra Joseph)

After expressing her views on the council's decision to not amend the ordinance, Ms. Nelson informed the council that Ms. Sandra Joseph has relocated her mobile home outside of the city limits.
