September 3, 2024

The New Roads City Council met in regular session at 5:30 o'clock P.M. Tuesday, September 3, 2024 at the City Hall in New Roads, Louisiana. Mayor Theron Smith called the meeting to order. A roll call resulted as follows:

Mayor's Report


Mayor Smith commented on the New Roads Connect app and encouraged everyone to sign up for the free application.
